IPLE is a new multidisciplinary Bachelor's programme offered by the Faculty of Political, Economic and Social Sciences, providing up-to-date knowledge in the fields of political science, law and economics. Students can specialize themselves choosing either the "International Politics and Economics" curriculum or the "International Politics and Law" one. In the former case, they acquire a wide array of skills and tools for the comparative analysis of politics and economic policies; in the latter, they will delve into international studies, including international and European law, and the political history of specific regions of the world.

GPS GLOBAL POLITICS AND SOCIETY

GPS is a two-year Master's programme aimed at preparing highly qualified professionals, providing the key skill-sets to understand and analyse complex dynamics associated with globalization and increased international interdependence. To this end, students will benefit from a multidisciplinary training in the fields of political science and sociology, complemented by key competences in law and economics.

Core modules will provide for the cutting-edge concepts and skills necessary to address the multidimensional dynamics of globalization and their impact on the functioning of contemporary societies and political systems; in addition, six optional modules will enable students to strengthen their knowledge in specific thematic areas, choosing from a wide range of suggested tracks.





PPPA POLITICS, PHILOSOPHY AND PUBLIC AFFAIRS

Jointly offered with the Departments of Philosophy of UNIMI and of the Vita-Salute San Raffaele University, PPPA is an interdisciplinary Master's programme providing a solid theoretical background in political science and philosophy combined with a practical sense of the challenges and opportunities connected to current political and socialeconomic phenomena. Students will acquire advanced analytical skills and the capacity to develop normative or policy proposals thanks to specialized training in argumentative strategies and empirical methodologies and through courses tackling highly-debated public questions related to two thematic areas, "Technology, science and society" and "Prosperity, peace and international affairs".
