#### UNIT 1 – This is me

READING: 4-option multiple choice; a magazine interview.

VOCABULARY: Words connected with personality; nouns with -ity/-ness; Collocations with adjectives.

GRAMMAR: present simple; present continuous; stative and action verbs; quantifiers.

LISTENING: 3-option multiple choice (pictures).

SPEAKING: asking for personal information; Questions.

LANGUAGE IN USE: 4-option multiple choice cloze; phrasal verbs.

WRITING: an informal email.

### **UNIT 2 – Home sweet Home**

READING: 3-option multiple choice; a short message.

VOCABULARY: Words connected with the house and home; phrasal verbs; word patterns.

GRAMMAR: past simple; past continuous; used to; would.

LISTENING: 3-option multiple choice (interview).

SPEAKING: Extended turn (photos).

LANGUAGE IN USE: Open cloze; so, such, too, enough, really, very, extremely, absolutely, definitely, etc.

WRITING: an article.

#### UNIT 3 - On the Road

READING: gapped text; a project.

VOCABULARY: Words connected with holidays; adjectives with negative prefixes *un-*, *in-*, *in-*, *in-*, *il-*, *dis-*, word patterns.

GRAMMAR: present perfect simple and continuous; Countable and uncountable nouns.

LISTENING: 3-option multiple choice (dialogues).

SPEAKING: discussion (pictures).

LANGUAGE IN USE: Open cloze; phrasal verbs.

WRITING: a review.

### UNIT 4 – Give it a go

READING: matching; an online guide.

VOCABULARY: Words connected with outdoor activities; phrasal verbs; collocations connected with free time

GRAMMAR: futures: Be going to and will; present simple and present continuous for the futures.

LISTENING: multiple matching.

SPEAKING: general conversation; expressing opinions.

LANGUAGE IN USE: key word transformation; contrastive clauses: although, even though, despite, in spite

WRITING: an article.

### UNIT 5 - In good health

READING: matching; an online article.; paraphrasing.

VOCABULARY: words connected with health and illness; phrasal verbs; Collocations with have, take, make

GRAMMAR: modals (1 and 2): ability, obligation, advice, permission, possibility, probability, certainty: can, must, have to, should, be able to, could, may, might, ought to, can't, mustn't,

LISTENING: 3-option multiple choice (interview).

SPEAKING: questions; talking about habits.

LANGUAGE IN USE: word formation: sufixes to form nouns: -ity, -ion, -ness, -ment, -ation.

WRITING: a story.

## UNIT 6 – A piece of cake

READING: 4-option multiple choice; an article.

VOCABULARY: words connected with food; phrasal verbs; word formation: adjectives/nouns/verbs.

GRAMMAR: relative pronouns and relative clauses (defining/non defining); articles (definite/indefinite- no article).

LISTENING: gap fill; recognising similar meaning.

SPEAKING: Extended turn (photos); describing situations and actions.

WRITING: An email

La riflessione sulla lingua è stata approfondita e rinsaldata sul testo di grammatica in adozione: Vince, Muzzarelli, *Get inside grammar*, Macmillan Education. In particolare, dopo un ripasso delle strutture acquisite alla scuola media, sono state affrontate le seguenti sezioni riguardanti le principali strutture esercitate durante l'anno:

UNIT 1: indefinite article; definite article, zero article, plural of nouns; subject/object pronouns; Be; there is, there are; demonstratives; possessives; have got; imperative; qualifying adjectives; interrogatives: who, what, where, why, how, when, whose...?; saxone genitive; numbers, dates, time; prepositions of time and place.

UNIT 2: present continuous; stative verbs; present continuous (other uses); contrast present simple/present continuous; adverbs of frequency;

UNIT 3: affirmative, negative, interrogative forms of past simple of be, past simple of regular and irregular verbs; affirmative, negative, interrogative forms; short answers; past continuous, contrast past simple/past continuous; used to and would; used to/be used to; present perfect simple; present perfect with always, often, ever, never, just, already, still, yet, so far; contrast present perfect simple/past simple; present perfect simple and past simple with how long, for, since, ago; present perfect continuous, present perfect simple/ present perfect continuous;

UNIT 4: present continuous and present simple used for the future; be going to, future simple will; contrast present continuous, be going to, will.

UNIT 5: Modals and deductions; can/can't, be able to, could/couldn't, may, might; be allowed to, shall, must/mustn't, have to; should; ought to; had better;

UNIT 6: Imperative;

UNIT 8: countable and uncountable nouns; some, any, no, none; much, many, a lot of; too, enough, too much/too many; (a) little, (a) few; compounds of some, any, no, every; qualifying adjectives (ed/-ing,) very, quite, rather); indefinite adjectives and pronouns, both, either, neither, none of.

UNIT 10: adverbs of manner; comparatives and superlatives and special cases; so, such, too, enough; result clauses;

UNIT 12: basic structure sentence; echo questions; question tags; relative pronouns;

UNIT 13: relative defining/non-defining clauses;

UNIT 14: Zero, first conditional;
