First Practice and Grammar Points

- Unit 1: be/get used to, used to; vocabulary (lifestyle, clothes); collocations with get
- Unit 2: gerunds and infinitives; vocabulary (music, sport); affixes

- Unit 3: comparisons, articles; vocabulary (technology); expressions with as...as; word formation (nouns)
- Unit 4: so, such; past tenses and time linkers; vocabulary (films); collocations with take; participle adjectives and adverbs
- Unit 5: modals of obligations, necessity and permission; vocabulary (the world of work); prefixes and suffixes.
- Unit 6: defining and non-defining relative clauses, vocabulary (relations and describing people); causative verbs
